Navy then took a power 20 and then added another power 10 to walk past Princeton by $2\frac{1}{2}$ seats at about 1100m. Princeton battled back to cut Navy's lead to one seat by the 1500m mark. At this point Princeton started their sprint. Navy was able to fend off the Princeton boat until the 1650m. The end of the race was a neck to neck battle to the finishline, Princeton winning by .5 seconds.

 4. The Varsity Race: Navy had trouble at the start and fell behind by a length at the settle. By 500m the Princeton boat had about four seats open water on Navy. The Navy team then started to get the boat moving. With a power 20 just before the 1000m mark, Navy was able to close the open water gap. At 1250m Navy took a silent power 10 to walk on Princetom and be down by only seven seats. The race ended with Navy still seven seats down after Princeton put on their sprint, loosing by 2.5 seconds.

- 2. The Plebe Race: The Plebes felt they rowed their best race that the State at the settle. They started at a 40spm but found themselves down 3 seats at the settle. Navy then caught a wake at 600m and fell 3 seats farther behind. The boats remained the same distance apart until both boats started their sprints. Harvard then pulled away by 2 more seats to finnish 8 seats ahead of Navy.
