Princeton 150s Win 2d Crown

ANNAPOLIS, Md., May 18 (AP) —Princeton's 150-pound crew out-sprinted Harvard at the finish today to win its second straight Eastern championship by a quarter of a length.

The unbeaten Tigers, winners of 15 straight the past two years, covered the 1 and 5/16 mile Severn River course in 6 minutes, 51.3 seconds. Harvard's time was 6:52.3. Yale was, third, three quarters of a length behind Princeton.

A quarter mile from the finish Princeton and Harvard took the lead away from Yale, which had held it most of the way.

The Tigers crossed the line at a pace of 40 strokes per minute.

Nine schools were entered in the regatta. Cornell finished fourth in 6:56.3. Trailing in order were Navy (6:57.7), MIT, (6:58.3), Dartmouth (7:04.3) Penn (7:13.3), and Columbia (time not announced).
