

# Navy Beats Penn by Three Lengths To Win Callow Cup 2d Straight Year

Navy won the Callow Cup for the second straight year in the third annual lightweight regatta on the Schuylkill in Fairmount Park yesterday, when Penn's 150-pound boat lacked the final drive and lost by more than three lengths.

The Navy junior varsity also won while LaSalle College heavyweight freshmen beat Penn's 150-pound freshmen in a close finish.

It ruined the debut of Charley Colgan, Penn's new 150-pound coach, although his crews fought to the bitter end on the placid river, over the Henley distance of one mile and five sixteenths.

The Naval Academy varsity 150s, rowed in the absence of their coach, Russell S. (Rusty) Callow, donor of the Cup, but led from start to finish. The lead was slight until after the half mile mark was reached, when the Middies started to open up water to win by more than three lengths.

Navy was clocked in 6:52.4, to Penn's 7:08.4.

Penn came closest to victory in the jayvee 150s, where the Red and Blue boat was ahead much of the first mile, only to lose to a beautiful final sprint as the crews rowed past Peters Island. Navy, coming from behind, pushed right to the finish, winning by three-quarters of a length in 6:57.4. Penn was timed in 7:00.4.
